### And here's the formal stuff.....Yes we do have a constitution.....

The Fullers Bridge Residents Association (FBRA) was established in November 1978 and is for the residents of River Ave, Fairyland Ave, Lobelia St & Quebec Road ("Fullers Bridge")

As per the constitution, the objects of the Association are:

- a) To represent residents' opinions in the advancement of the area to maintain and improve council services and transport services – to protect the environment
- b) To do all such other things as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects
- c) To render assistance to residents where warranted and possible, in accordance to above
- d) To co-operate with local councils, planning authorities and other bodies to achieve these objectives

We meet 4 times a year to discuss upcoming social events and matters of relevance to the community. Between meetings, where required, individual members / small teams volunteer to work on specific projects.

Our FBRA Annual General Meeting will be held as usual at the beginning of Frog Hollow's Christmas Party at Wirong Flats on 9 December 2012. This is an opportunity for residents to be updated on matters of concern and to elect the committee for the coming year.

This year we are hoping to attract new members as some long standing committee members have advised they will be stepping down. I'd like to take this opportunity to thank Dave Sharp & Tim Gates (+10 years) and Pamela Gilbert (7 years) for their valuable contribution to the FBRA committee and the Frog Hollow community.

New members can be young, old and anywhere in between. A couple of projects which are top of mind where we do need help include updating our website and helping with an idea to capture the collective knowledge of the residents to create a pictorial history of Frog Hollow and the surrounding area.
